Junction Box Racks

INTENDED USE

To prevent galvanic corrosion from contact between two different metals type. The plates insulate the different materials from one another, and are used together with insulation sleeves for fastners. (see ØI-RD-UG-EN-0001)

INSTRUCTION FOR USE

Ensure the surfaces to be connected are free from debris or sharp points which might penetrate the insulation. Fit the insulation pads between the sections being joined, and use insulation sleeves on all fasteners.

Check that there is no continuity between the parts being insulated using a multimeter/resistance gauge.

Note: PTFE material can creep under high compression loads, thereby reducing the tension on bolted connections over time. Consideration for this should be taken when using insulation plates for load bearing or structural connections.
